




Q2 What size is your Council?


Q3 How many Councillor places are there on your Council?



Q5 What Area is your Town/Parish/Community Council/Meeting in?





Q7 Has your Council agreed to a Climate Emergency?



Q8 Has your Council got a Climate Change Action Plan?



Q9 Has your Council considered/undertaken Climate Change Projects?








Q18 Has your Council got a Health and Well-Being Policy?










Q23 Has your Council's Clerk attended training in the last 12 months?














Q32 Do you prefer virtual or face to face training?


Q33 If you are prepared to travel for training how far would you be willing to travel?







Q38 Is your Clerk CiLCA qualified?




Q39 If not, is your Clerk working towards the CiLCA?

Q40 Does your Clerk have equivalent qualifications?






Q42 Does your Council hold the General Power of Competence?









Q50 Has your Council contacted KALC for advice in the last 12 months?



Q51 How does your council rate the KALC advice service overall?








Q53 If applicable, Is your Council a member of the Direct Access scheme?


Q54 If your Council is already part of the scheme, has your Council ever contacted NALC for advice?




